*Add: sentences and words.
Have I described using my 5 senses?
Have you added more details, similes, metaphors, or personification?
My beginning-paragraph catches the reader's attention and is 2-3 sentences long.
I have three reasons with three separate paragraphs
Each reason has a topic sentence with supporting details.
*Remove: unneeded words/sentences.
My composition does NOT have any repeating words or phrases.
My entire narrative/essay is ON TOPIC
*Move: change a sentence or word placement.
My composition is in chronological order and follows a sequence of events.
*Substitute: trade words or sentences for others.
Have you changed boring words to interesting words?
My sentences DO NOT begin with a conjunction (for, and, nor, but, or, yet, so, because)

## Editing Checklist Think "CUPS"

*Capitalization: names, places, months, titles, I	
All sentences and proper nouns begin with a capital letter.	
All other letters and words are lowercase.	
*Usage: match nouns and verbs correctly	
All sentences are complete (they answer who? Did what?)	
Nouns are always introduced before replacing them with pronouns	_
I am using verbs that are in the same tense.	
I do not have any run on sentences.	
*Punctuation: periods, quotes, commas, question marks	
All sentences end in a period question mark or evalences:	
and the factor mark, or exclamation point.	
If someone in my composition is talking, I have quotation marks and commas to separate talking from the person talking.	
Apostrophes are used to show ownership.	
I have used commas before any conjunctions and to separate words on a list.	
changed borded to interesting words?	
I checked spelling and fixed the words that didn't look right
